All Wheel Drive vs. 4 Wheel Drive: Which is Right for You?

Both All Wheel Drive (AWD) and 4 Wheel Drive (4WD) rotate all four wheels at the same time, so what's the difference and which is right for you? AWD and 4WD have two types - full-time and part-time. With full-time, all four wheels are driven all the time, whereas with part-time AWD, all four wheels are engaged when additional traction is needed or when the driver selects to change modes. Simply put, the difference between AWD and 4WD is that 4WD is better equipped to handle extreme terrain, and is therefore most often found on trucks and large SUVs. So which is for you? AWD can be found on the widest range of vehicles with the least amount of compromises to the ride and fuel economy. 4WD is more suitable if you drive in remote areas, extreme conditions, or go off-roading frequently. Celebrating Women in Science: Grace Hopper

Grace Hopper (1906-1992) was a computer scientist and admiral in the United States Navy. Her achievements include being a part of the Harvard Mark I programming team, inventing the first programming languages, popularizing the term "debugging," and serving in the U.S. Navy Reserve during WWII. She was a pioneer in her field and is considered the mother of computing, working on projects that others thought impossible. It was uncommon for women to be doing her kind of work in the 50s and 60s, but we have her to thank for starting the work that got computers to where they are today. [Source](#)
